New Courses in 2010

CW168 BSc (Hons) in Environmental Science (CAO)

This is an exciting and timely new 4 year honours degree – Level 8 course. This course reflects an integrated approach to environmental protection and sustainable development and will equip graduates with the skills to pursue rewarding careers in diverse areas such as analytical services, local authorities, the pharmaceutical industry, environmental consultancies, environmental management and quality assurance.

Minimum Entry requirement: LC 2 HCs and at least 4 OD3s to include English or Irish and Maths.

CW178 BSc (Hons) in Sport Science (CAO)

This is a new and innovative 4 year Honours degree – Level 8 course. The course is suited to students with an interest in the science of sport and who are keen to learn about the role that science plays in sport performance. It is designed to develop the knowledge, skills and analytical techniques in the sub-disciplines of sport and exercise sciences.

Minimum Entry requirement: LC 2 HCs and at least 4 OD3s to include English or Irish and Maths

CW188 BSc (Hons) Sports Rehabilitation & Athletic Therapy (CAO)

This is a new 4 year Honours Degree – Level 8. This course is specially designed to enable graduates to become competent in supporting the medical and para-medical professions in the rehabilitation of the injured athlete. Graduates will act as sports rehabilitators, work with professionals, semi-professionals, amateur sports clubs and organisations, third level colleges and universities, rehabilitation institutions or sports injury clinics, or with sporting bodies.

Minimum Entry requirement: LC 2 HCs and at least 4 OD3s to include English or Irish and Maths.

CW706 Higher Certificate in Legal Studies - (CAO)

This is a new 2 year Higher Certificate – Level 6. This course is designed to equip students with a broad knowledge of the Irish legal system and of the fundamental legal principles and subjects. Graduates may expect to work as a Legal Executive, Law Clerk or Legal Secretary.

Minimum Entry requirement: 5 subjects at OD3 or better. Subjects required: English or Irish at OD3 or better & Maths.

CW758 BA (Hons) in Applied Social Studies (CAO)

This is a new four year honours Degree – Level 8. This course is designed for anyone interested in a career in social or community care services. Typical positions will be secured in residential services (adolescent, vulnerable older people,) community development, family support, community child-care and community disability services.

Minimum Entry requirement: LC 2 HCs and 4 OD3s to include English or Irish – Maths is not required.

CW768 BA(Hons) in Social and Community Studies (CAO)

This is a new three year honours Degree- Level 8. This honours degree blends the complementary discipline areas of social and community studies. Graduates will find employment in a range of community and voluntary settings including working with disadvantaged groups, co-ordinate advocacy groups and work with community bodies on community development projects.

Minimum Entry requirement: LC 2 HCs and at least 4 OD3s to include English or Irish. Mathematics is not required.

CW807 BA Sport & Exercise (GAA) - (CAO)

This is a new 3 year Ordinary Degree – Level 7. This course is delivered by IT Carlow in association with Comhairle Laighean and the GAA. The aim of the course is to provide an academic qualification that combines Coaching, Fitness, Player Development and Club Administration with a broad based academic business or communications curriculum relevant to the development of the sport. Graduates can seek employment in sports related business or public relations environments. Potential Career paths include Games Development, Sports Management, Club Development, Personal Coaching, Coaching Fitness, Business or Public Relations.

Minimum Entry requirement: 5 subjects at OD3 or better. Subjects required: English or Irish at OD3 or better & Maths.

CW526 Higher Certificate in Aircraft Systems (Avionics & Airframe)

CW927 BA Sport & Exercise (Soccer) - (CAO)

This is a new 3 year Ordinary Degree – Level 7. This course is delivered by IT Carlow in association with Football Association of Ireland. Potential Career paths include FAI Third Level Football Facilitator, FAI Development Officer, FAI Administration, Sports Management, Club Development, Coaching/Fitness, Business or Public Relations.

Minimum Entry requirement: 5 subjects at OD3 or better. Subjects required: English or Irish at OD3 or better & Maths.

Wexford Campus

CW037 Bachelor of Business in Business (CAO)

This is a new 3 year Ordinary Degree – Level 7 available at the Wexford Campus. This course will provide the student with a broad based business education. Graduates will find work in areas including: Trainee Manager, Financial Services, Public Service and Junior Management in any of the main business functions and across all industry and services sectors

Minimum Entry requirement: 5 subjects at OD3 or better. Subjects required: English or Irish at OD3 or better & Maths.

CW068 BA (Hons) in Applied Social Studies (CAO)

This is a new four year honours Degree – Level 8. available at the Wexford Campus. This course is designed for anyone interested in a career in social or community care services. It provides the graduate with the opportunity to develop the knowledge and skills to enable them to make a professional contribution to communities, groups, societies and organisations in the region, nationally and internationally. Typical positions will be secured in residential services (adolescent, vulnerable older people,) community development, family support, community child-care and community disability services.

Minimum Entry requirement: LC 2 HCs and 4 OD3s to include English or Irish – Maths is not required.

CW078 BA (Hons) in Economic & Social Studies (CAO)

This is a new 3 year honours Degree – Level 8. available at the Wexford Campus. This course is a two subject degree, designed for students to undertake specialised study in two subjects in the arts and social sciences, to degree level. It is an inter-disciplinary degree that will enable the student to develop critical and analytical skills, especially as they are developed through the study of Economics and Social Studies. Career opportunities include Public Service, Economic and Social Research, Financial and Business Institutions and Communications/Journalism.

Minimum Entry requirement: LC 2 HCs and 4 OD3s to include English or Irish – **Mathematics is required.**

CW088 BA (Hons) in Visual Communications & Design (CAO)

This is a new 4 year honours Degree – Level 8. available at the Wexford Campus. Students will create projects in design (graphics illustration, branding, advertising, editorials/magazines and signage) digital media (websites, mobile devices and games) and the moving image (video and animation).

Entry requirement: LC 2 HCs and 4 OD3s to include English or Irish – Maths is not required.

Exit Awards Honours Degrees/Ordinary Degrees

Students may choose to exit after two years with a Higher Certificate Award or after three years with an Ordinary Bachelor Degree Award – refer to specific course detail in the prospectus for more information.

IT Carlow achieves International recognition for its Engineering degrees.

The Institute of Technology Carlow achieved International recognition when Engineers Ireland accredited its degree programme in Civil Engineering as meeting the educational requirements for Ordinary membership (MIEI) of Engineers Ireland. This means that IT Carlow's degree is recognised worldwide under the Washington Accord allowing our Civil Engineering graduates to work as professional engineers in places such as Europe, United States and Australia..

As part of the same visit IT Carlow's ordinary degrees in Civil, Electronic and Mechanical Engineering were reaccredited as leading to Associate Membership (AMIEI). Associate Engineer means that these Engineering graduates can work as Engineering Technologists worldwide under the Sydney Accord.

The achievement of this recognition is a major step for IT Carlow and its School of Engineering.

IT Carlow Awarded Accreditation from the Honorable Society of Kings Inns

IT Carlow is delighted to announce that the three Year BA (Hons) in Law (CW 708) currently offered by the Institute has recently been accredited by the Honorable Society of Kings Inns. Accreditation was awarded in recognition of the quality and standard of the programme. As a result of this accreditation graduates from IT Carlow's Honours Law Degree will be eligible to take the entrance exams to the Honorable Society of Kings Inns on graduation and will not be first required to complete the two year Diploma in Legal Studies at Kings Inns. This will result in considerable savings both in terms of time and finance for those graduates who will go on to train for the professional qualification of Barrister-at-Law. Graduates of the programme will also be exempt from the Law Society of Ireland's preliminary examinations and are eligible for entry onto the Solicitors professional training courses.
