Recognition and Accreditation:

All of our courses at Dublin Business School through the CAO are awarded by Quality and Qualifications Ireland (QQI). DBS also has professional recognition attached to programmes from Professional bodies. Course Fees:

Please note DBS is an independent college and therefore fees apply. The fees for our undergraduate programmes for 2021/2022, are between €5,895 and €6,300 per annum.

The total fee includes all registration, tuition and examination costs. All our undergraduate courses have been approved for 20% tax relief.

Tax relief is available at the standard rate of 20% for the amounts exceeding €3,000 – up to €7,000.
