### 1. New Programmes

#### **GY133 – BA Education (Computer Science and Mathematical Studies)**

Was available in 2019 but appearing in CAO Handbook for the first time (2 places for mature students and 2 for QQI/FET)

#### **GY134 - BSc (Geography and Geosystems)**

A four-year programme for those with a strong interest in how natural systems function and how scientific and geographic protocols can be used to advance environmental issues such as climate change, energy use, sustainable development, and policy.

Subjects required include Irish, English, Mathematics and a Laboratory Science subject.

(2 places for mature students and 2 for QQI/FET)

#### **GY253 - Law and Taxation**

Subjects required include Irish, English, Mathematics and another Language

(1 place for mature students and 1 for QQI/FET)

#### **GY254 – Law, Criminology and Criminal Justice (BCL)**

Subjects required include Irish, English and another Language

(1 place for mature students and 1 for QQI/FET)

#### **GY321 - BSc Genetics and Genomics**

Subjects required include Irish, English, a Laboratory Science subject and Mathematics at minimum H5 or O1
