GY122 Na Dána (Cumarsáid agus Gaeilge) 4 Years (offered on NUI Galway campus in years 1, 2 and 4 with one semester of year 3 in An Cheathrú Rua). Offered in 2016 and appearing for the first time in CAO Handbook 2017

GY123 BSc (Applied Social Sciences) 4 Years

Interdisciplinary Degree with work based internship for 8 months (January-August) in Year 3. In year 1 students will study: Introducing the Social Sciences, Introduction to Sociology and Political Science, Psychology for Social Scientists, Introduction to Economic and Social Policy, Principles of Geography and Digital Citizenship.

Four strands are available in Years 3 and 4:

- Environmental Social Studies
- Politics, Society and Identity
- Creativity, Culture and Entrepreneurship
