General Information (FETAC/Qualifax):

Please note the following are the courses to be offered via CAO, as a result of the migration of courses from Failte Ireland to the HEI's.

- TL001 Higher Certificate in Arts – Culinary Arts
- TL002 Higher Certificate in Arts – Hospitality Studies
- TL003 Higher Certificate in Business – Tourism
- TL004 Higher Certificate in Arts – Bar Supervision
- TL005 Higher Certificate in Business in Front Office Management

Minimum Entry Requirements:

- 5 Leaving Certificate Ordinary D3's or an equivalent qualification (English must be included in the subjects passed). Foundation Level Maths will be accepted at B2
- FETAC Level 5 in any discipline.
- RPL (Recognition of Prior Learning) will be considered where applicants can demonstrate sufficient learning gained in a relevant work-based context. Applicants may apply as **non-standard**.
- The Leaving Certificate Applied programme **does not** meet the minimum entry requirements on its own merit. However, in order to be eligible to be considered for a place on the relevant programme, learners with a post qualification level 5 award **or** with appropriate work based learning are eligible to apply. In this case a minimum of 1 year's industrial experience is required, in addition to attending and passing the relevant ITT interview. Applicants may apply as **non-standard**.

Students may be eligible to apply for European Social Funding (E.S.F.), if they meet the criteria (income assessed). Tuition fees and capitation fees will be paid in the academic year 2010/11 by Failte Ireland. Further information on funding is available at <http://www.studentfinance.ie>.

Application will be directly via the CAO (www.CAO.ie or alternatively 091-509800), before the 1st February 2010.

Progression opportunities to both Ordinary degree (level 7) and Honours Degree (Level 8) programmes are available for all applicants who meet the entry requirements.
