The following programmes have been added for 2026:

- DB516 Bachelor of Arts (Honours) Business (Supply Chain Management)

The fees for a Full-time BA (Hons) in Business (Supply Chain Management) are €6,060 per annum for EU students.

The following programmes have been removed for 2026:

- DB502 Bachelor of Science (Hons) in Computing (Data Analytics and Big Data)
- DB503 Bachelor of Science (Hons) in Computing (Software Development)

We offer Level 6, 7 and 8 courses through CAO and for QQI routed students:

Entry requirements:

2H5 + 4O6/H7, to include Maths & English or another language for level 8 programmes. Please see individual course entry requirements for further details.

For level 6 and 7 programmes, applicants must obtain a minimum of 5 O6/H7, including a language. Some degree programmes will also require a minimum of O6/H7 in Maths.

There are some courses that Maths is not a requirement and they can be found within the online prospectus at www.dbs.ie

Recognition and Quality

All of our undergraduate courses offered through the CAO are awarded by Quality and Qualifications Ireland (QQI).

We ensure our degrees connect directly to the professional world. Many of our programmes also have essential **professional body recognition**. For example, our popular BA (Hons) in Psychology is recognised by the **Psychological Society of Ireland (PSI)**, and for future solicitors, our Bachelor of Laws (Hons) LLB is recognised by the **Law Society of Ireland** and the **Honourable Society of King's Inn**. This means your DBS degree is a direct pathway to your career.

Course Fees and Value

As an independent college, fees do apply. For our undergraduate programmes in the 2026/2027 academic year, the tuition fees range **between €6,045 and €6,440 per annum**. This total fee is comprehensive, covering all your registration, tuition, and examination costs—no hidden surprises.

All of our undergraduate courses are approved for **20% tax relief**. This relief applies to amounts between €3,000 and €7,000, further information can be found on the revenue website.
