# The following programmes have been added for 2025:

• DB535 Bachelor of Arts (Honours) Sustainability Management

The BA (Hons) in Sustainability Management programme aims to provide learners with the knowledge, skills, and mindset necessary to address global sustainability challenges, as well as creating and maintaining sustainable operations in the public, commercial and not-for-profit sectors. Moreover, the decision to align the curriculum of this proposed BA (Hons) in Sustainability Management programme with the 17 United Nations Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) is rooted in the recognition of the urgent need to address global sustainability challenges. By integrating the SDGs into our curriculum, we aim to provide students with a comprehensive understanding of the interconnected nature of sustainability issues and empower them to contribute meaningfully to achieving the SDGs.

The fees for a Full-time BA (Hons) in Sustainability Management are €5,995 per annum for EU students.

We offer Level 6, 7 and 8 courses through CAO and for QQI routed students:

## **Entry requirements:**

2H5 + 4O6/H7, to include Maths & English or another language for level 8 programmes. Please see individual course entry requirements for further details.

For level 6 and 7 programmes, applicants must obtain a minimum of 5 O6/H7, including a language. Some degree programmes will also require a minimum of O6/H7 in Maths.

There are some courses that Maths is not a requirement and they can be found within the online prospectus at www.dbs.ie

## **Recognition and Accreditation:**

All of our courses at Dublin Business School through the CAO are awarded by Quality and Qualifications Ireland (QQI). DBS also has professional recognition attached to programmes from Professional bodies. For example, one of our most popular programmes, BA (Hons) in Psychology, is recognised by the Psychological Society of Ireland (PSI), and our Bachelor of Laws (Hons) LLB is recognised by the Law Society of Ireland and the Honourable Society of King's Inn.

#### **Course Fees:**

Please note DBS is an independent college and therefore fees apply. The fees for our undergraduate programmes for 2025/2026, are between €5,995 and €6,375 per annum. The total fee includes all registration, tuition and examination costs. All our undergraduate courses have been approved for 20% tax relief.
