2026	<b>DN411 Diagnostic Radiography (Graduate Entry)</b>	It will no longer be necessary for applicants to have completed research activity as part of their primary degree in order to be eligible.
2027	<b>All with FET route</b>	For all our FET routes from 2027, scoring will be based on a single sitting. It is hoped that this will reduce random selection on 390 points.
2027	<b>DN400 Medicine</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Leaving Certificate scores above 550 will no longer be moderated</li><li>HPAT weighting will be reduced from 300 down to 150</li></ul>
2027	<b>DN420 Physiotherapy</b>	A third language will no longer be required .

2027	<b>DN240 Sustainability</b>	The three degree options taken from Year 2 will be changed to : Sustainability – Society and Governance Sustainability – Enterprise and Economics Sustainability – Environmental Science
2027	<b>DN530 Humanities</b>	The following two degree options will be removed : <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Irish Studies</li><li>The Irish Language and Culture</li></ul>
