**GY505 Pharmacy** – 4-year degree leading to BSc Pharm (level 8) 5-year leading to MPharm (level 9- required to be a pharmacist)

#### 3. Other Changes to Programmes:

**GY101** - The subject Geography in BA Joint Honours has the new title of 'Geography, Climate and Sustainability'.

**GY204 BComm (International Spanish)**- The language entry requirement for this course has changed for 2026. Leaving Cert applicants are now required to present a minimum H4 in Spanish to be eligible for this programme.

**GY201 BComm and GY209 BComm Global Experience** – Spanish will no longer be available as an option for these courses.
