The following outlines changes and important updates for students commencing their studies in September 2024.

New programmes

LM027 Bachelor of Laws (LLB) in Common And Civil Law

At the time of an offer, an applicant is required to hold the Leaving Certificate (or equivalent), with a minimum of six subjects. Results must include: • Grade H5 (Higher Level) or better in at least two subjects and • Grade O6 (Ordinary Level)/H7 (Higher Level) or better in at least four subjects Notwithstanding the above, an applicant must have a minimum of an F6 in Mathematics, an O6/H7 in English, and an O6/H7 in another recognised language.

In addition, applicants must also hold a minimum Grade O6 (Ordinary Level)/H7 (Higher Level) or better in French.

LM104 Bachelor of Science in Occupational Therapy

At the time of an offer, an applicant is required to hold the Leaving Certificate (or equivalent), with a minimum of six subjects. Results must include: • Grade H5 (Higher Level) or better in at least two subjects and • Grade O6 (Ordinary Level)/H7 (Higher Level) or better in at least four subjects Notwithstanding the above, an applicant must have a minimum of an F6 in Mathematics, an O6/H7 in English, and an O6/H7 in another recognised language.

In addition, applicants must also hold a minimum Grade O3/H7 in Physics, Chemistry, Physics with Chemistry, Biology, Physical Education or Agricultural Science.

LM113 Interaction Design (Replacing LM122)

At the time of an offer, an applicant is required to hold the Leaving Certificate (or equivalent) with a minimum of six subjects which must include: Two H5 (Higher Level) grades and Four O6 (Ordinary Level) grades or four H7 (Higher Level) grades. Subjects must include Mathematics, Irish or another language, and English.

In addition, applicants must hold a minimum grade O3/H7 in Mathematics.

A Special Mathematics Examination will be offered at UL following the Leaving Certificate results for those students who did not achieve the Mathematics requirement. Mature applicants must apply through the Central Applications Office (CAO).

LM114 Music Media and Performance Technology (Replacing LM122)

At the time of an offer, an applicant is required to hold the Leaving Certificate (or equivalent) with a minimum of six subjects which must include: Two H5 (Higher Level) grades and Four O6 (Ordinary Level) grades or four H7 (Higher Level) grades. Subjects must include Mathematics, Irish or another language, and English.

In addition, applicants must hold a minimum grade O3/H7 in Mathematics.

A Special Mathematics Examination will be offered at UL following the Leaving Certificate results for those students who did not achieve the Mathematics requirement. Mature applicants must apply through the Central Applications Office (CAO).

LM116 Engineering - Additional Common Entry Award - BE/ME Digital Mechatronic Engineering

New degree award included in LM116 common entry Bachelor of Engineering In Digital Mechatronic Engineering.

Please Note: Students can add on 1 year to achieve an ME in all courses for LM116 except Design and Manufacturing Engineering.

LM122 Creative Media and Interaction Design

The common entry programme has been split into two programmes, LM113 Interaction Design & LM114 Music Media and Performance Technology. LM122 is no longer offered as common entry.

LM126 Bachelor of Engineering In Electrical Engineering

Applicants are required to hold at the time of enrolment the established Leaving Certificate (or an approved equivalent) with a minimum of six subjects which must include: Two H5 (Higher Level) grades and Four 06 (Ordinary Level) grades or four H7 (Higher Level) grades. Subjects must include Mathematics, Irish or another language, and English.

In addition, applicants must hold a minimum grade H4 in Mathematics and a grade 06/H7 in any one of the following: Physics, Chemistry, Physics with Chemistry, Engineering, Construction Studies, Design & Communication Graphics/Technical Drawing, Technology, Biology, Agricultural Science, Applied Maths.

Changes to Existing Programmes

The entry requirements are changing for LM096 from 2024 entry. The entry requirements for 2024 entry are as follows:

LM096 BSc (Education) in Physical Science with Chemistry and Physics

Applicants are required to hold at the time of enrolment the established Leaving Certificate (or an approved equivalent) with a minimum of six subjects which must include: Two H5 (Higher level) grades and Four O6 (Ordinary level) grades or four H7 (Higher Level) grades. Subjects must include Mathematics, Irish or another language, and English. In addition, applicants must hold an H4 grade in Mathematics and an H4 grade in at least one of the following: Physics, Chemistry, Physics with Chemistry, Engineering and Applied Mathematics.

Garda Vetting is required for this programme.

Additional Entry Requirements

- LM131 Bachelor of Arts in Irish Music
- LM132 Bachelor of Arts in Irish Dance
- LM133 Bachelor of Arts in Contemporary Dance

LM134 - Bachelor of Arts in Voice LM135 - Bachelor of Arts in World Music

1st February applicants will be invited to a face-to-face audition to be held in March 2024. Later applicant auditions will be held on a rolling basis and applicants will be communicated with inviting them to audition.

Note: Applicants will also have the option of submitting audition materials online if they cannot travel to Limerick.

LM076 BSc Product Design & Technology

A portfolio is required for entry. Applicants are informed via email after applications close.

LM099 B Arch Architecture

LM099 is not going to have a portfolio requirement for school leavers for 2024. Mature applicants will be interviewed and will be advised to bring material to support their application.

LM103 BSc Paramedic Studies

Applicants must provide evidence of a Valid Full Clean B and either a Provisional C1 or Full Clean C1 Licence, prior to offer of a place on the course. Deadline for submission is the 31st July.

Applicants must produce a Valid Full Clean C1 Licence by the end of Year 1 of the course.

LM173 Bachelor of Science in Immersive Software Engineering

Portfolio is required for 2024 entry.

Applicants are required to submit a portfolio of creative work, and a written statement, and may be called for an interview.

Special Mathematics Examination: Faculty of Science & Engineering

The Faculty of Science & Engineering run a Special Mathematics Examination, which can be used as an alternative to Higher Level Leaving Certificate Mathematics for entry to Undergraduate Programmes in the Faculty. The examination is based on the Higher-Level Mathematics syllabus. Candidates taking the examination must achieve the equivalent of the Leaving Certificate grade required for entry to the programmes to which they are applying.

Please note the following:

- Applicants must have satisfied all other entry requirements for the programmes to which they are applying.
- Applicants must also have achieved the points required for entry to the programme.

- Applicants who achieve the required result in the Special Mathematics Examination and satisfy all other entry requirements and achieve the required points for the programme will be considered for an offer in Round 2 as part of the CAO offers allocation process.
- The Special Mathematics Examination is not available at Ordinary Level.
- The Special Mathematics Examination can only be used to satisfy the Mathematics requirement for programmes offered by the Faculty of Science & Engineering.
