NEW €19 MILLION SPORT SCIENCE CENTRE

The University will begin construction in summer 2025 of a three-storey extension to the Phoenix Sports and Restaurant Building. The new extension will include:

- > a state-of-the-art student gym
- > a sports / multi-purpose hall
- > changing facilities

MU hopes that the provision of these extensive modern gym facilities will encourage students to visit the gym regularly, improving their physical fitness, reducing stress levels and promoting mental wellbeing.

The new centre will also provide students and staff with enhanced educational opportunities in a purpose-built facility with a modern and comfortable teaching environment. The new Sport Science Department and the Sports Office will both be located in the complex, fostering collaboration and mutual support between the two.

*MH701 BSc General Nursing - QQI FET Entry Route

Applicants must present the FULL major award, taken in a single sitting, of any one of the following QQI-FET Level 5 major awards with a minimum credit value of 120 and distinctions (80% or better) in a minimum of five modules:

- Nursing Studies (5M4349) Level 5
- Healthcare Support (5M4339) Level 5
- Community and Health Services (5M4468) Level 5
- Health Service Skills (5M3782) Level 5

The following modules must be included as distinctions:

Anatomy and Physiology (5N0749) **and** Nursing Theory and Practice (5N4325) **or** Care Support (5N0758)
