Subject: Nua Ghaeilge
Modification: To offer an additional 15 ECTS in Nua-Ghaeilge in 1st year, (as a double subject).
Clár: MH101 Baitsiléir Ealaíon
Ábhar: Nua-Ghaeilge
Leasú: 15 ECTS sa bhreis sa Nua-Ghaeilge sa chéad bhliain (ábhar dúbailte)

Programme: MH101 Bachelor of Arts
Subject: Politics
Correction: The MU Prospectus 2026 incorrectly states that Politics is available as a Major from second year. Politics is available as a Double Major or as a Minor from second year.

Programme: BA Creative Writing and English
Modification: To enable an internal transfer mechanism, with conditions, for students taking English in MH101 at the end of First Year to Year 2 MH111.

Programme: BSc Biotechnology MH202 [M14]
Modification: Year 1, inclusion of Data Science as an optional subject. Year 4, increase the placement module BI430 from 15 to 25 credits and remove BI423 (10 credits).

Programme: MH804 BA Adult, Community, Further Education (flexible part-time)
Modification: Modification to meet Teaching Council requirements – course length changed from 4.5 years to 6 years. (Note: the course length of the other two strands within MH804 remain at 4.5 years)

Applicants must present the FULL major award, taken in a single sitting, of any one of the following QQI-FET Level 5 major awards with a minimum credit value of 120 and distinctions (80% or better) in a minimum of five modules:

- Nursing Studies (5M4349) Level 5
- Healthcare Support (5M4339) Level 5
- Community and Health Services (5M4468) Level 5
- Health Service Skills (5M3782) Level 5

The following modules must be included as distinctions:

Anatomy and Physiology (5N0749) and Nursing Theory and Practice (5N4325) or Care Support (5N0758).

Meeting the eligibility requirements does not guarantee an offer of a place.

We are currently reviewing QQI/FET entry requirements for all courses. These entry requirements are subject to change. Please note that QQI/FET courses 5M21473 and 6M21471 will only be eligible for entry to MU degree courses MH003 and MH004 from 2026 entry.
