



## **Mary Immaculate College – Alert List 2026 entry**

**MI009 BA in English Language and Literature is not running in September 2026 and the programme has been discontinued.**

**MI010 BA in Drama and English was introduced in 2024 and will continue to run.**

Minimum Entry Requirements:

**Grade H5** in a higher level paper in not less than **two subjects**.

**Grade O6/H7 in four other subjects** (Higher or Ordinary Level) including Mathematics, Irish or another Language and English.

This programme is Level 8 and is a four year programme.

Approximately 15 places available on this programme (1 to 2 mature and 1 to 2 QQI students included)

### **Increase in Number of Places for MI022**

From September 2025, the number of places on MI022 (BA Education Home Economics & Business Studies) increased from 15 to **28 places** with 4 places for QQI and 5 places for Mature applicants.

However we do offer an Access Programme on to MI004/MI005 through the Teacher Education Access Programme (TEAP) for people who are 22 years of age or over.
