CAO Mature Applicant Checklist

1. Check Application Requirements

- Confirm with the Admissions Office of your chosen institution whether you need to apply through CAO or directly.
- Read the CAO Handbook: www.cao.ie/handbook
- Visit HEI websites and prospectuses for entry requirements and course details.

2. Create CAO Application

- Complete your online application at www.cao.ie/apply
- Register before **1 February at 5 pm** to avoid restrictions.

3. Select Relevant Qualifications and Assessment Categories

- In the CAO form, select all applicable qualification categories (e.g., Mature Applicant, Leaving Certificate, QQI FET/FETAC, Higher Education, etc.).
- You may select multiple categories if relevant.

4. Enter Course Choices

- Enter course choices before 1 February at 5 pm.
- List courses in genuine order of preference.
- For restrictions: www.cao.ie/restrictions
 For changing choices: www.cao.ie/com

5. Complete Mature Applicant Section

- Log in to your CAO account via 'My Application'
- Complete the Mature Applicant section before 1 March at 5 pm.

6. Provide Qualification Evidence

- Submit evidence of listed qualifications within 10 days of applying or by 10
 February at 5 pm.
- Do **not** list qualifications without providing evidence.
- You may upload or post your documents to CAO. Do not do both. For upload instructions go to www.cao.ie/upload or for instructions on posting your documents go to www.cao.ie/post

7. Evidence of English Language Competency (if applicable)

- If English is not your first language, provide evidence of English language competency.
- Contact the Admissions Office of the institution for specific requirements.

8. Exceptions for Specific Courses

- Mature applicants to nursing/midwifery, primary teaching, and graduateentry courses are not required to complete sections 1–11 of the Mature Applicant form.
