The Central Applications Office (CAO) website contains a number of valuable resources that are easily accessible from the 'Student Resources' section of www.cao.ie

Resources include the CAO Handbook, an online 'Demo Application', video guides, correspondence schedules, checklists and a timetable of important dates.

CAO encourages all applicants to become familiar with the application process by using the 'Demo Application' facility, reading the Handbook and watching the video guides explaining the different elements of the application process. Applicants are also encouraged to visit 'Applicant News' section of the website.

The answers to most questions are available in the CAO Handbook or online, but for anything that applicants cannot find an answer to they can use the 'Contact' section of the website where their query will be answered, usually with one working day.
